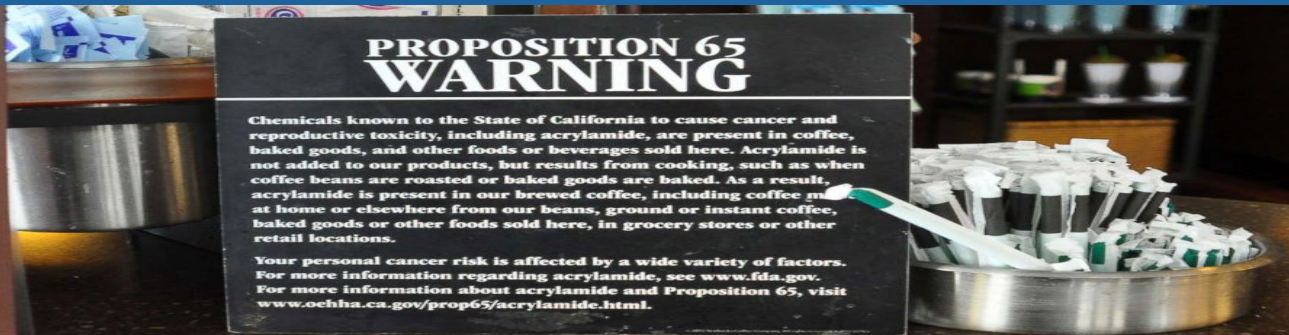


Meeting Your RESPONSIBILITIES for Proposition 65

COMPLIANCE



> **Businesses who make or sell products in California must provide a “clear and reasonable warning” before knowingly or intentionally exposing anyone to a listed chemical**

- Labeling a consumer product
- Posting signs at the workplace or public area
- Distributing notices
- Publishing notices in a newspaper
- Internet notices on the product page

Once a chemical is listed, companies have 12 months to comply with warning requirements.

> **Proposition 65 prohibits companies from knowingly discharging listed chemicals into sources of drinking water.**

Once a chemical is listed, businesses have 20 months to comply with the discharge prohibition.
