


Introduction


What?

SiliconExpert recently developed a new feature 'Inventory Alerts' to notify customers of different kinds of stock movements as early as possible without needing to login to the site, to have proactive planning to avoid shortages thru maintaining accurate records for **Inventory**.

Inventory Alerts will be integrated into P5 Alert Manager, which will allow the customers to:

- Set up and manage alerts on the part number level.
- Receive daily emails with inventory changes once the predefined options are achieved.
- View and manage alerts in the alert timeline.

How?



To Add Inventory Alert

Inventory alerts are available on the **part number level**. Users can set up the alert from (BOM Manager Grid, ACL Grid, Part Search Grid, and Part Details) by *selecting the options for the specific part number* to receive updates on 'Inventory Changes'.

Setup

Part Number Level

- Inventory alerts allow users to track changes in the quantity of stock of components from authorized distributors. There are four configurable options:
 - **Option #1:** Receive notifications when the part goes out of stock. (Quantity becomes 0)
 - Option #2: Receive notifications when the part comes back in stock. (Quantity changes from 0)
 - **Option #3:** Receive notifications when the total stock quantity per individual distributor is equal to or greater than a certain amount. (Quantity increased to or above amount X)
 - Option #4: Receive notifications when the total stock quantity per distributor is equal to or lower than a certain amount. (Quantity decreased to or below amount X)
 - ☑ Users can select any or all options and they will be alerted once an option meets their desired threshold.
- Inventory alerts also allow users to track inventory changes on components for only specific distributors. Otherwise, they will be notified of inventory changes for components from all distributors.

BOM Level

Inventory alerts are available on the part number level. It's not currently available on BOM or part list level, but a user can still set an alert on selective PNs from the BOM manager.
